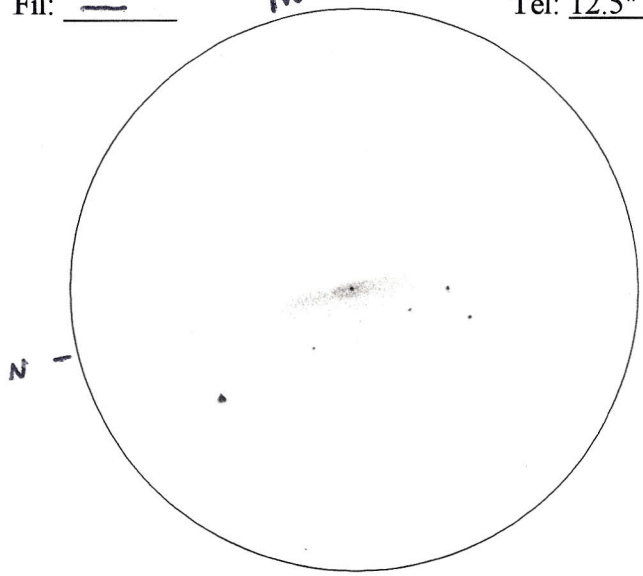


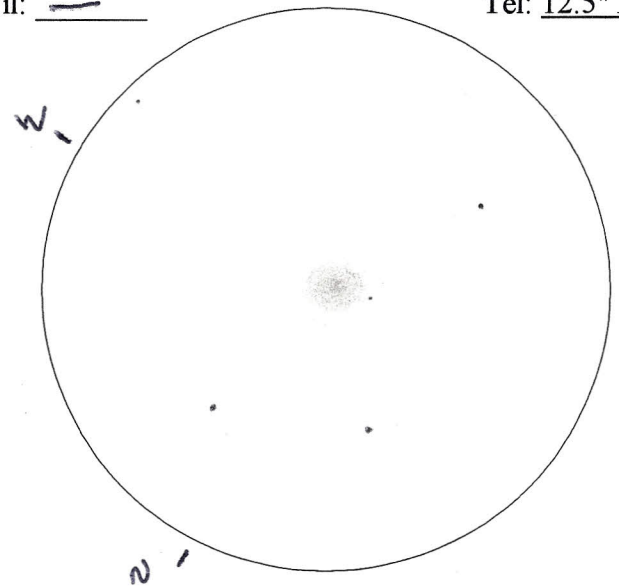

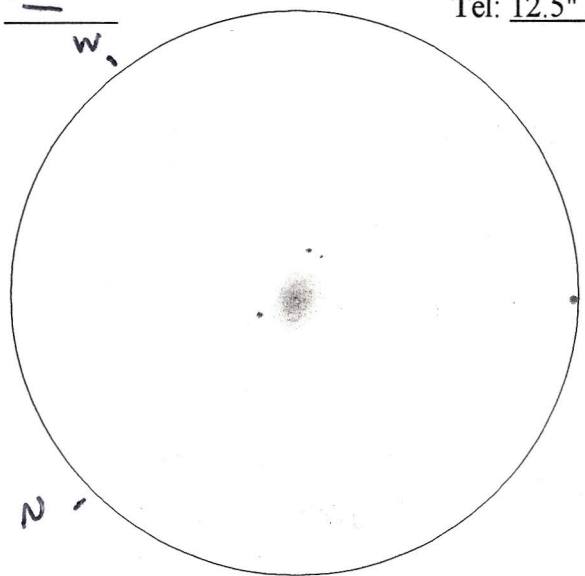
Halo dim and extremely elongated. Core bright and elongated w/ bright starlike nucleus. Elongated N/S.

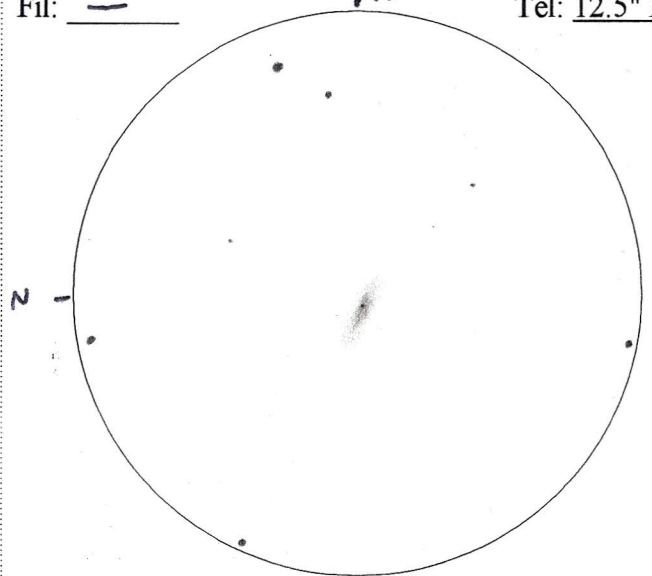
A very dim, circular cloud with an extremely faint core.
